\*\*\* Students who receive scores of either 4 or 5 on both the PHYSICS (B) and the PHYSICS (C) exams can only receive credit for PHYSICS (C): PHYS 101 and 102. Credit will not be granted for both PHYS 141/142 and PHYS 101/102 as per departmental policy.
